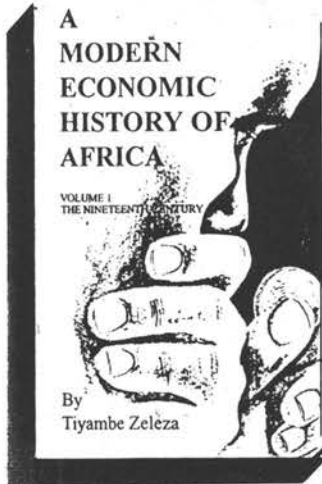

The century also saw the beginnings of the ruthless and bloody quest for foreign domination.
